DEFINITION OF A READMISSION APPLICANT

COMPLETION OF FORM

WITHDRAWAL FORM

It is your responsibility to have an official withdrawal form on file at the Office of the Vice President of Student Affairs. You must also make arrangements to clear any debts to the University of any holds on your record.

TRANSCRIPTS

If you have attended another college/university since leaving PSU, it is your responsibility to have official transcripts forwarded to the Admission Office.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Art Candidates – Applicants must submit a portfolio to the Chair of the Art Department.

Music/Theatre Candidates – Applicants must participate in an audition. Arrangement for the audition must be made with Chair of the Music and Theatre department.

DEADLINES

Fall Semester – April 1 **Spring Semester** – December 1
