Guidelines for Stipend to Study Abroad

- Applicants must submit a one-page description of student's project, the goals, and how the project will support and strengthen their academic experience at PSU.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Any student may apply in conjunction with an academic course or performance study.
- The selection committee will be advised of the total funds available for distribution each year. The committee will then decide the amount of each award and the number of scholarships that will be awarded.
- All students may apply once per year but preference will be given to students who have not received the award previously.
- Application submission deadlines are:
October 30th for the following Dec-May period; March 30th for the following May-Dec period.
- Selection committee is appointed by the Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs.
- Scholarship can be used for independent study or for group activities organized by PSU.
- Eligible PSU students must be registered for credit (or transfer credit) to be considered for this award.
- Students must be enrolled PSU students in a degree program (declared major) and must have at least one semester of study left in their curriculum to be considered.
- Awards are based on the following:
 - Extent to which the proposed project is related to the student's major
 - Quality of the written proposal
 - Letter of recommendation
 - Student's plan to share their experiences with Plymouth (post-trip plan)
 - Academic achievement (GPA)
