Less than 30	1.50
30-45.5	1.60
46-59.5	1.75
60-74.5	1.85
75-89.5	1.95
90-115.5	1.96
116 and above	1.98

NOTE: If you are re-taking a PSU "F" at another college/university, you must complete a Transfer Credit Approval form (available through the PSU Undergraduate Studies Office) prior to taking class.
