\*In 2000-2001, PSU instituted a year-long, open-entry, open-exit term (the General Session) for all off-campus graduate and distance learning courses. A number of summer graduate courses that previously had been taught in the regular summer term were moved to the General Session, thus adversely impacting enrollment in the regular summer term. See the General Session report for enrollments in off-campus and distance learning courses.

**Note:** This report counts individuals enrolled in either of our two summer sessions. Students are counted by status, not by the level of course enrolled in (i.e., an undergraduate enrolled in a graduate course is counted with the undergraduates). Through 2002, students taking courses in both sessions are counted twice. Includes courses for credit posted to the transcript (omits Audit but includes late withdrawals). FTE in this report represents the total credit hours divided by 12 for undergraduates and by 9 for graduate students.
