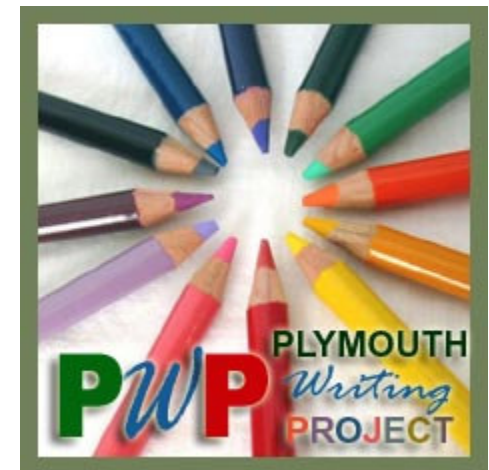

About the Institute:

This summer institute runs on the same principles that guide the Plymouth Writing Project invitational institute. It is designed for teachers who would like to gain a thorough background in the teaching of writing with practical applications they can use in their classrooms.

Participants will write and respond to each other's writing, and reflect on how this experience informs their thinking about their teaching.

They will learn about research and theory related to the teaching of writing in reading research groups. They will also do guided research on a topic related to their teaching.

They will devise and practice strategies which they will use in

their classroom. They will workshop these strategies with groups.

SESSION DATES

The institute runs from June 30th through July 17th.

All Sessions will be held on the Plymouth State University Campus and will run Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Participants should plan to attend all sessions.

The Staff:

All staff have been trained by the Plymouth Writing Project and are Teacher Consultants in the teaching of writing.

Meg Petersen is the director of the Plymouth Writing Project. She teaches English at Plymouth State University with a concentration on writing and English education courses.

COST:
