

ROOM HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

The following prohibited items are absent from the room:

- Candles
- Incense and Incense Paraphernalia
- Oil Lamps
- Propane Tanks (or other types of fuel tanks/containers)
- Halogen Lamps, Lava Lamps
- Electric Blankets
- Any Open-Coiled Appliances (toasters, toaster ovens, hot plates, "George Foreman" style grills, heating/immersion coils, electric frying pans, etc)
- Space Heaters (unless approved by RD/Housing Manager)
- Any Non-UL Listed Appliances

The following expectations for extension cords are followed:

- Proper extension cords (those that are grounded; have a third prong) are used and used properly.
- There is no more than one (1) power strip plugged into a single wall outlet.
- Power strips are plugged directly into outlets (not into extension cords).
- Power strips are fuse protected.
- Electrical cords DO NOT run underneath carpets or other areas where there is pressure.

The following life safety expectations/policies are being followed:

- Smoke detector is intact and working properly.
- Lighting fixtures, smoke detectors, sprinkler systems, and ceiling area (within reason) are free of paper, cloth, and decorations.
- Pipes, sprinkler lines, smoke detector, doorway, and ceiling area are free of hanging electrical (and non-electrical) items, such as lights, cords, etc.
- Door closer is intact and functioning properly.
- Door, windows, and floor are free of obstructions (allowing exit of the room).
- Heating system is free from blockage.

The following expectations regarding general cleanliness and care of room are being followed:

- Rooms should be kept clean, reasonably sanitary, safe, and orderly at all times.
- Creating holes in walls is not permitted.
- Duct tape and stickers may not be attached to any walls, ceiling, floor, doors, windows, fixtures, room surface, or University furniture.
- Glow in the dark substances (laundry detergent, paint, chalk, etc.) may not be used on walls, ceiling, floor, doors, windows, fixtures, room surface, or University furniture.
- University furniture that was part of the original room inventory may not be removed from the room or building (unless authorized by a RD/Housing Manager).
- Items may not be placed on window ledges.
- Only approved light bulbs may be used in light fixtures.
- Light fixtures may not be tampered with.
- Present locks or security devices may not be altered or replaced.
- Additional locks or devices may not be installed.

The following University and/or Housing policies and expectations are being followed:

- For underage residents, alcohol is not present in the room (unless there is an "of-age" roommate).
- Alcohol paraphernalia is not present in the room (including funnels, empty/decorative containers, etc).
- Drug paraphernalia is not present in the room (including pipes, scales, "blow tubes", etc).
- University furniture that was not part of original room inventory is not present in the room.
- Windows and screens are intact (have not been removed or tampered with).
- Pets (other than non-threatening fish in a max. 15 gallon tank) are not permitted.
- Unauthorized possession of University property or property of another is prohibited.
- Possession of items considered "weapons", according to the Student Handbook, is not permitted.
