*Students must earn a 2.00 or better grade point average in each course within the Option. Varsity Athletics (PE 197) is recommended. One of the 3 Coaching courses may also count as a fulfillment of the Team Sport category Activity requirement. Students are encouraged to take a foreign language to satisfy the **Global** Perspective. **Scientific** Perspectives must be completed by either taking courses in 2 different disciplines and taking a **S-Lab** with 1 of those courses, or by taking 2 consecutive semesters of lecture and 1 semester of lab in a year-long science course. **Upper-division** Requirement is completed outside the major discipline. Neither the **Writing** course nor the **Integrative** component can be satisfied with transfer credit; they must be taken at Plymouth.
