*Complete 3 courses beyond the introductory level from one of the following: Ceramics, Drawing, Painting, Printmaking and Sculpture. Studio Area must be completed before Senior Thesis I and II. Senior Thesis must be completed in 1 academic year (fall-spring). Students are encouraged to take a foreign language to satisfy the **Global** Perspective. **Scientific** Perspectives must be completed by either taking courses in two different disciplines and taking a **SLAB** with one of those courses, or by taking two consecutive semesters of lecture and one semester of lab in a year-long science course. **Social and Psychological** Perspectives must be completed in two different disciplines. **Upper-division** Requirement is completed outside the major discipline. Neither the **Writing** course nor the **Integrative** Component can be satisfied with transfer credit; they must be taken at Plymouth.
