To fulfill the General Education Upper-Division Requirement, students must complete either an academic minor outside of the Social Science Department or 9 credits of 3000/4000 level courses in disciplines outside the Social Science Department. **Scientific Perspectives** must be completed by either taking courses in 2 different disciplines and taking a **SLAB** with 1 of those courses, or by taking 2 consecutive semesters of lecture and 1 semester of lab in a year-long science course. Neither the **Writing** course nor the **Integrative** Component can be satisfied with transfer credit; they must be taken at Plymouth.
