AR 1140 and AR 2510 must be taken in sequence. Students must take a foreign language which will satisfy the **Global** Perspective. **Scientific** Perspectives must be completed either by taking courses in two different disciplines and a **SLAB** with one of those courses, or by taking two consecutive semesters of lecture and one semester of lab in a year-long science course. **Social and Psychological** Perspectives must be completed in two different disciplines. **Upper-division** Requirement is completed outside the major discipline. Neither the **Writing** course nor the **Integrative** Component can be satisfied with transfer credit; they must be taken at Plymouth.
