Graphic Design I, II, III and IV must be completed before Graphic Design V and VI. Graphic Design V and VI must be completed in one academic year (fall-spring). Students are encouraged to take a foreign to satisfy the Global Perspective. Scientific Perspectives must be completed either by taking courses in two different disciplines and a SLAB with one of those courses, or by taking two consecutive semesters of lecture and one semester of lab in a year-long science course. Social and Psychological Perspectives must be completed in two different disciplines. Upper-division Requirement is completed outside the major discipline. Neither the Writing course nor the Integrative Component can be satisfied with transfer credit; they must be taken at Plymouth.
