A minimum of 21 credits in the major must be at the 3000/4000 level. Students must take a foreign language which will satisfy the **Global** Perspective. **Scientific** Perspectives must be completed either by taking courses in 2 different disciplines and taking a **SLAB** with 1 of those courses, or by taking 2 consecutive semesters of lecture and 1 semester of lab in a year-long science course. **Social and Psychological** Perspectives must be completed in 2 different disciplines. **Upper-division** Requirements is completed outside the major discipline. Neither the **Writing** course nor the **Integrative** Component can be satisfied with transfer credit; they must be taken at Plymouth.
