




### Important Notes:

- Cumulative data reflects PSU's initiation of protocols starting in late July for regular screening through COVID-19 testing.
- Data are presented according to the date tests are administered. Counts for most recent dates may be incomplete, but will be updated as results are reported
- Quarantine refers to the practice of separating individuals who have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 to determine whether they develop symptoms or test positive for COVID-19. Quarantine also reduces the risk of transmission if an individual is later found to have COVID-19. Quarantine for COVID-19 should last for a period of 14 days after the exposure has ended.
- Isolation keeps someone who is sick or tested positive for COVID-19 without symptoms (asymptomatic) away from others.

- A close contact is defined as any individual who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to positive specimen collection) until the time the patient is isolated.
- \*Off-campus quarantine locations close on April 30th -- As of 4/21 no new students are being admitted given I/Q timeframes.
