




### Important Notes:

- Cumulative data reflects that data collected since August, 14, 2021.
- Data are presented according to the date tests are administered.
- Quarantine refers to the practice of separating individuals who have had close contact with someone with COVID-19, to determine whether they develop symptoms or test positive
- Isolation keeps someone who is sick or tested positive for COVID-19 without symptoms (asymptomatic) away from others
- Household Contacts per NH DHHS definition: "any individual who lives and sleeps in the same indoor shared space as another person diagnosed with COVID-19 (either a temporary or permanent living arrangement), leading to close contact and potential repeated exposure to the person with COVID-19. This includes situations where there may be temporary but prolonged exposure such as occurs as sleep-over events, shared camp cabins, vacation rentals, etc.". For PSU, this would be residential hall or student apartment roommates and off-campus housemates that share a bedroom.
- Result counts do not include past positives received after an isolation period would have elapsed.
- Fully Vaccinated means: An individual having completed the full 2-dose series of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines with at least 14 days elapsed since receiving the second dose or having received the single dose Janssen/J&J vaccine with at least 14 days elapsed since receiving the dose. (At this time, completed vaccination with a WHO-approved vaccine is considered fully vaccinated.)
