

# Senior Project Fall 2016

**New Senior Project Process for 2016:  
initially all projects will be submitted to Dr. Peter Drexel**

**TIME TO GET YOUR PROJECT SUBMITTED**

The **deadline** for abstract submission is **Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup>**

## Process In Brief :

### Abstract

Complete an abstract for the project you wish to propose. This should include both a project title and a short summary of the project idea. You may submit more than one abstract if you wish. This **must** be submitted to Dr. Peter Drexel **by Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup>**, or you will not be allowed to participate in senior project next semester.

### Advisor Selection

The department will meet on Wednesday, April 27<sup>th</sup> to assign project advisors. You will be notified via email once your advisor has been assigned.

### Proposal Completion

Use the CS&T Department's SP Proposal form to submit your proposal (found on the department website on the senior project page.) Work with your project advisor to complete the form. A full draft of this proposal is due to your advisor by **Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>**. If your proposal does not receive final approval at this time, you will receive conditional approval and will be expected to make the appropriate adjustments by the first day of the fall semester. **Failure to turn in a draft proposal by the deadline or complete the appropriate corrections if you receive conditional approval will result in not being allowed to take senior project this semester.**

### Presentations

There is one more step. You **must** attend at least a portion of this semester's SP presentations. (Be sure that the person taking attendance knows that you're there!)
