

Advanced Graduate Studies in Higher Education

The Higher Education courses (HD) are offered for graduate students during all four terms throughout each year. Advanced graduate studies students may select any one or more of these courses as they develop their programs of study. The Practicum courses are limited to fully admitted students who have approval from their advisor, but all other courses are open to any advanced graduate student. Students who are fully admitted into the Higher Education program will work with their advisor to develop an individualized program of study in either Administrative Leadership or Curriculum and Instruction.
