

Undergraduate Conditional Acceptance

Plymouth State University offers conditional admission to qualified applicants who meet the academic requirements of the University but who do not yet meet the University's English language proficiency requirement. Students who are conditionally accepted must fulfill the University proficiency admission requirement by successfully completing level 112 of ELS or by presenting the required TOEFL or IELTS score.

Application Deadlines:

Fall: May 1st

Spring: December 1st

Items needed for applying to PSU undergraduate programs:

_____ Completed and signed application (Common App) and the \$50 application fee

_____ Most recent TOEFL score:
 minimum paper score = 520
 computer-generated score = 190
 online score = 68

or IELTS score (minimum score = 5.5)

or successful completion of ELS

Language Centers Level 112

or other evidence of your ability to use and understand the English language

_____ A notarized International Financial Certification Form, which includes copies of bank verification (evidence of financial ability to afford university costs)

_____ Notarized copies of your high school transcript translated in English

_____ Notarized copies of your college transcript translated in English.

_____ A copy of your valid passport and visa (if you are a visa holder).
