

Housing

Housing Process and Eligibility:

- Admitted students apply for housing online
- On-time applicants are guaranteed university housing
- First-year and second-year undergraduate students are required to live on campus
- Meal plan options are required for all students living in residence halls unless they are 21 years of age or of junior status
- Housing available on campus all four years

Facilities:

- Five traditional residence halls with double, triple, and limited single occupancy for first-years and up
- Langdon Woods residence hall for upperclassmen offers single and double rooms with private bathrooms, as well as four-person suites with a common bathroom and living space

- The White Mountain Apartment complex offers two-person, one-bedroom; two-person, two-bedroom; four-person, two-bedroom; and limited single apartments
- All housing within walking distance of classes, dining, student support services, campus shuttle, public transportation, recreation, and student activity center
