LOON LAKE CAMP

Please take note of the following information regarding PSU's Loon Lake camp. This document is intended to clarify the use of the camp.

****THE LOON LAKE CAMP IS AVAILABLE TO FACULTY, STAFF and ALUMNI FOR PERSONAL USE UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ONLY****

Use of Plymouth State University's Loon Lake camp is limited. The camp property and access to the lake are available for faculty, staff & alumni through a PSU lottery process or as part of a registered PSU program with faculty or faculty appointed supervision ONLY. Loon Lake is a "private" lake with no public access and for this reason Faculty, Staff and Alumni can not access the lake via the camp property unless they have reserved, been awarded & paid for a week through the lottery and have been issued a permit or they are part of a PSU program that has registered to use the camp. All faculty, staff and alumni are welcomed to submit reservation requests via the Loon Lake camp link located on the Physical Plant website. All requests are entered into a lottery-style process in April and the available weeks will be allotted to faculty, staff and alumni in this manner. Those interested in reserving the camp as part of a PSU program should contact Physical Plant prior to April of each year. The camp season begins in May and ends in early October (weather permitting). As a courtesy to all registered camp guests, we ask that you PLEASE pay strict attention to the no trespassing signs located at the camp and this notice to avoid any unnecessary action. If you have personal watercraft or property currently located at the camp please remove it as soon as possible or contact UPD to arrange a time when it can be removed.
