Education Works for New Hampshire

Whereas: The New Hampshire state government cut funding for the University System of New Hampshire schools in 2011 from \$100 million to \$52 million, the University of New Hampshire, Plymouth State University, Keene State College and Granite State College have all been negatively impacted; and

Whereas: This decrease in funding and state support has affected all four campuses and their abilities to provide fiscally competitive educational opportunities; and

Whereas: That the students of Plymouth State University, University of New Hampshire, Keene State College and Granite State College believe that without the full restoration of previous funding, New Hampshire Public Higher Education will quickly lose the ability to attract in-state students and provide them with an affordable educational option; and

Therefore

Let it be

Resolved: That the Plymouth State University Student Senate supports the objective of the University System of New Hampshire to advocate that the state government reinstate the full funding of \$100 million for public higher education; and
