Important Agreement Policies

Please note the Social Science Elective with a double asterisk **, when notated please take a course at NHTI with a the prefix ANTH, ECON, HIST, INDL, POLS to meet the general education requirement at PSU.

Choice: General Education Directions

One of each of the Directions must be completed, with a Choice allowed for the remaining Direction credits needed. A student may need to complete more than 20 credits to satisfy the Direction's requirement.

Directions required for degree completion include:

Creative Thought Direction, Past and Present Direction, Self and Society Direction and Scientific Inquiry Direcion

Three credits for IS 1111 become electives for transfer students entering with 24 or more credits.

The maximum number of transfer credits that can be applied to a PSU bachelor's degree is 90.

Students coming to PSU must have grades of C or better in each of their courses and a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA in order to transfer into the PSU BS in Early Childhood Education, Early Care and Education under this 2+2 agreement.

Students who have completed the AS degree in Early Care and Education for Young Children with Disabilities with one course with a grade of C- or below, may retake that course during the summer preceding entrance to PSU and will be accepted at PSU under this 2+2 agreement, if she/he earns a grade of C or higher.

If a student has not completed the AS degree in Early Care and Education for Young Children with Disabilities then courses will be transferred on a course-by-couse basis.
