**2+2 Agreement: AS in Business Studies at MCC to Business Administration at Plymouth State University**

**Important Agreement Policies**

**Credits toward BS degree**

The maximum number of transfer credits that can be applied to a PSU bachelor degree is 90.

**2+2 Requirements**

Students coming to PSU must have grades of C or better in each of their courses and a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA in order to transfer into the BS in Business Administration under this 2+2 agreement.

Students who have completed the AS degree in Business Studies with one course with a grade of C- or below, may retake that course during the summer preceding entrance to PSU and will be accepted at PSU under this 2+2 agreement, if a grade of C or higher is earned.

If a student has not completed the AS degree in Business Studies, then courses will be transferred on a course-by-course basis. Please reference Transfer Database below for course-by-course equivalents.
