Application Checklist

Submit a Housing Application

In the Housing Application, there will be information on what Living-Learning Clusters are available for New Incoming Students and where to apply for them.

Complete the Living-Learning Cluster Application

Using the following link, https://plymouth.erezlife.com/login/, select the option to "sign in with your school account". This option will bring you to a page to use your PSU credentials to sign in to the platform where the application lives. Once in the platform, locate the Living-Learning Cluster Application. If you need assistance with the application, there is a video on the page here to assist you.

Monitor your PSU email

If an application is lacking information, a notification will be emailed to students/applicants instructing them to make the necessary edits. Additionally, formal offers/invitations to the Living-Learning cluster will be emailed to students by June 15, 2023.

Special Notes & Considerations

Academically Linked Learning Clusters

Students looking to live in Health Professions MUST be a Nursing, Allied Health, or Exercise and Sports Physiology major, as those majors share the common course required for this Living-Learning Cluster.

Roommate Preferences

Only Roommate preferences that include approved applicants will be considered. This means that you and your preferred roommate need to submit an LLC application and be approved to become eligible for assignment in the LLC Building.

LLC Locations for New Incoming Students

Geneva Smith Hall will house all First-Year Living-Learning Cluster, and only students in an LLC will be permitted to live there. There are several non-academically linked cluster options for students to consider if they wish to live in Geneva Smith Hall as First-Year Students.
