Affinity: University Apartments (4-person 2-bedroom) Affinity Clusters enables members of recognized student organizations to live together in campus housing. These groups are formed around a shared interest or common goal to elevate the residential experience and promote a sense of belonging. In addition, members of affinity communities live the campus mission of Ut Prosim by giving back to the area through service and educational and social events.
