

PHYSICAL THERAPY 3+3



Students in the DPT 3+3 program will complete their undergraduate requirements in the first three years, and move into the DPT coursework during senior year.

STEP 1

Apply to Plymouth State for either the BS in Allied Health Science -OR- the BS in Exercise Science & Sport Management. Your application will be reviewed for the minimum qualifications which include an overall 3.5 or better GPA, at least 3 years of science and 3 years of math coursework.

STEP 2

Complete required undergraduate coursework, achieve a cumulative 3.5+ GPA and 3.3+ in science coursework by the end of fall semester of junior year, earn B- or better in all prerequisite courses. Complete 25+ hours of observations in the on-campus PT clinic. At the end of 2nd year, submit a written statement of intent to continue into the DPT program.

STEP 3

Submit PTCAS Application Students who meet the above requirements will complete the standard application process in the fall semester of junior year to secure their reserved seat in the DPT cohort for the upcoming summer term. This process includes the PTCAS application, an essay, statement of purpose, two professional recommendations, an interview with DPT faculty, and the required application fee.
