

# NH ED Subject Area Test Requirements

For NH Licensure, The Ed 500 Administrative Rule (currently Ed 505.01/Ed 514.01 formerly) requires each candidate to pass a subject area content knowledge test when seeking teacher licensure in any one of the major areas of concentration in which the NH State Board of Education has established a passing score. In 2024, the NH DOE adopted tests administered by Pearson National Evaluation Series for teacher candidates to meet the basic skills and subject-area requirements. At this time, both the ETS Praxis assessments and the Pearson National Evaluation Series assessments are accepted for licensure in NH. As of July 1, 2025, some licensure areas that did not previously require assessments will do so. These tests are not required for graduation or for recommendation for licensure. However, it is strongly recommended that teacher candidates complete the tests required for licensure in their area as soon as possible (after coursework is completed), preferably before the internship begins, while coursework is still fresh and to make licensure as efficient as possible after graduation.

You can also submit out of state/national testing reports for evaluation as a comparable test.*

*Elementary Education K-8 requires (in addition to the requirements for Elementary Education K-6) a 15 credit concentration on your transcript in one of the following areas: English, Math, Science, or Social Studies. You must also submit passing scores on the corresponding Middle School content test. <https://praxis.ets.org/state-requirements/newhampshire-tests.html> You can also submit out of state/national testing reports for evaluation as a comparable test.*
