The *foreign language* requirement for all BA degrees calls for 0-8 credits: one year of one language (6-8 credits); **or** one 3000/4000 level world language course (3 credits); **or** being a native speaker of a language other than English (zero credit). A minimum of 24 credits in the major must be completed at the 3000/4000 level.
