

NH State Loan Repayment Program (SLRP):

- Provides funds to health care providers working in medically underserved areas in NH.
- Available to providers who are willing and able to commit to a three-year FT contract or a two-year PT contract at an eligible facility.
- School Psychologists in Medicaid to School programs are eligible to apply
- Behavioral Health Professionals and Substance Use Disorder providers who are licensed or who are under supervision to become licensed are also eligible to apply
- Can help offset both undergraduate and graduate loans

Eligibility Requirements:

- U.S. citizenship
- Must not be receiving loan reimbursement from another entity
- Be licensed in NH (or under supervision to become licensed)
 - Those under supervision to become licensed must be providing services full-time at an [eligible facility](#), have completed their education, and have been under supervision for at least one year
- Must be able to begin work once contracted for full-time or part-time work

[Applications](#) accepted on a rolling basis and reviewed each quarter.

What Professions and Licenses are Eligible for the NH SLRP?

- Mental Health Counselors - Including LADC and MLADC
- Marriage and Family Therapists
- School Psychologists

Occupational Sites Eligible for SLRP ([see full list](#)):

- Community Mental Health Centers
- Substance Use Disorder Treatment Centers (ONLY outpatient-focused eligible)
- The 9 NH Doorways (mental health)
- Federally Qualified Healthcare Centers (FQHC)
- Rural Health Clinics
- Critical Access Hospitals

In addition to the sites listed above, all healthcare providers and practice sites in designated shortage areas are eligible if

- they provide direct outpatient services
- they offer a sliding-fee scale based on current federal poverty guidelines and accept Medicare, Medicaid, and provide free-care when medically necessary.

SLRP Loan Repayment Awards:

- MHCs, MFTs, MLADCs, and Behavioral Health professionals under supervision towards licensure can be eligible for
- up to \$65K in loan repayments for full-time (min. 40 hrs/wk)
- up to \$22.5K in loan repayments for part-time (min 20/max 39 hrs/wk)

National Health Service Corps (NHSC) Loan Repayment Program:

- Provides funds to health professionals working in rural and underserved communities.
- Eligible occupations include behavioral health professionals (such as clinical mental health counselors), marriage and family therapists, licensed professional counselors, and substance use disorder counselors (such as MLADCs)

Eligibility Requirements:

- U.S. citizenship
- Possess a current health professional license in the discipline in which they are applying to serve
- Participate or be eligible to participate as a provider in Medicare, Medicaid, and Children's Health Insurance Programs (CHIP)
- Be eligible for federal employment
- Be employed at or have accepted a position at a site approved by the NHSC
